## **STUDENTS MUST WEAR PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**

### **DURING RIDING SESSIONS; Equipment to be worn**

Helmets DOT approved

Full finger gloves with no holes

Long pants

Shirt or jacket with long sleeves

Shoes or boots that completely cover the ankles with socks.

Eye Protection-(sun glasses etc.) Rain Suit (optional)

## **We Supply the Motorcycles.**

The classes will be run rain or shine. You may register over the phone with a **Visa or Master Card**. This keeps you from having to send anything through the mail. If you are 18 or older you may fill out the waiver upon arrival. If under 18 the waiver must be sign by parent or legal guardian and brought to the class before the class starts. The class dates are not on our web site [www.gcmti.com](http://www.gcmti.com) due to holidays. **Give us a call and we will give you the class dates over the phone.**

It is recommended that the student take into consideration their mental and physical health and the time of the year for taking the course. It does get hot in the summer and cold in the winter. We ride motorcycles regardless of the temperature.

## **FEES**

**The Basic Motorcycle Rider Course: \$220.00**

**The Experienced Rider Course: \$100.00**

Question: What if I register for the class and I am unable to attend?

Answer: If you give us more than 5 days notice prior to the class, we will reschedule you at no extra charge. If you give us 5 days or less, we will reschedule you, and a one time \$50.00 rescheduling fee will be assessed. Only one rescheduling fee will be permitted. If no notice is given or you are late on any day of the class, then the \$220.00 fee will be forfeited and the full fee will be required again. Remember, if you are not there, someone else could have taken your place. A valid driver license is required to take this course. If you register for this course and your driver license is not valid you will not receive credit for completing the course and you will forfeit the fee paid.
